An apprenticeship is a way for young people and adult learners to earn while they learn in a real job, gaining a real qualification and a real future. There has never been a better time to consider an apprenticeship. Young people can 'get in and go far' with some of Britain's biggest and brightest companies and gain the skills and knowledge they need to succeed, in some cases up to degree level, while working and earning. Information, Advice and Guidance

Full-time education

The government has raised the participation age so that you will need to continue in learning until you are 18. This is not the same as saying that you can't leave school until you are 18.

A very high percentage of young people decide to carry on with education on a full-time basis in 6th form, college or with a training provider.

After 16, most young people choose to follow either an academic route or to do vocational training. Some choose to take a mixture of the two routes. If you didn't get English and maths GCSEs at grade C or above, you will continue to study those subjects alongside your A Levels or other qualifications.

AS and A Levels

There are many different A Level subjects. You might continue with the subjects you studied at GCSE or choose new courses. You will need to have good grades at GCSE to get onto a course. Assessment will be mainly by exam at the end of the course. AS Level results will no longer count towards a final A Level grade.

Extended Project Qualification

The Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) is often taken alongside A Levels. You research a topic of your choice and then present a detailed report or other piece of work.

International Baccalaureate

Some schools offer the opportunity for you to study the International Baccalaureate (IB) as an alternative to A Levels. Students taking the IB study a range of subjects.

Higher Education

The qualifications you gain in 6th Form, college or with a training provider may lead you on to employment, an Apprenticeship or to continue your learning in higher education. If you are planning to study for a degree or beyond, you probably already know about the huge range of subjects and places to study that you can choose from. You could opt for general subjects like maths, English or biology or those linked to a specific career such as teaching, dentistry or architecture.

Apart from "traditional" 3 year courses taken at a university or college, there are other ways to achieve a degree level qualification. Your options may include taking BTEC courses at levels 4 and 5, distance learning, or studying abroad for all or part of your degree. Many Apprenticeship frameworks also lead to degree level qualifications.

Work-related learning

Work-related learning can lead to vocational qualifications in your work area and are supported by employers and professional bodies.

Work-related qualifications are on offer in a range of subjects covering:

A general, broad area like art and design, engineering, or hospitality and catering. These are often on offer in school or college and may include practical assessments and tests as well as written exams.

Or a narrower job-specific area linked directly to an occupation for example graphic design, car mechanics or food and beverage service. There are unlikely to be any exams to take but you will have to produce evidence to show that you have gained the skills you will need to do the job. You may be able to study while you are at work, or your employer may send you to a local college or training provider to complete your course.

You may take vocational qualifications as part of an Apprenticeship or as part of your programme in full or part-time education.

Apprenticeships

An Apprenticeship is a real job with training so you can earn while you learn. You will work alongside experienced staff to learn job-specific skills. You will be paid at least the Apprenticeship Minimum Wage and get most of the same benefits as your fellow workers – including paid holidays.

You will also work towards valuable nationally recognised qualifications; for example a National Vocational Qualification (NVQ), a technical certificate such as a BTEC or City & Guilds and functional skills in maths and English. This could mean that you will be spending some time at a local college or a specialist training organisation, often either one day a week or in blocks of a few weeks. Apprenticeships take between one and four years depending on the type and level of Apprenticeship. You could progress through the levels up to a Higher Apprenticeship or to a university degree.

Traineeships

A Traineeship is for anyone who is almost, but not quite, ready to get an Apprenticeship or job. Courses last from six weeks to six months, with the content tailored to your individual needs. You will get work-preparation training (for example CV writing and interview skills) and meaningful work experience. You will also get English and maths support to give you the literacy and numeracy skills needed for the workplace.

A Traineeship gets you ready and gives you the confidence to take the first step in your career, such as an Apprenticeship, by making you more attractive to potential employers.

Every day, many hundreds of thousands of people move into, around, and out of London on their way to work. The number of jobs is generally increasing at a faster pace than anywhere else in the country. London has a higher percentage of workers who are qualified to a high level and who work in well-paid professional occupations than across the rest of the UK.

Wages tend to be higher in London – but then so does the cost of living!

Unemployment in London among young people is very high at the moment, there are plans to create many thousands of new jobs including more Apprenticeships. Most workers in London work in jobs where they are providing a service rather than in production jobs in manufacturing, farming or fishing.

Qualification levels

There is likely to be a continuing demand for skilled, experienced workers with degree level or appropriate trade qualifications. Unskilled job vacancies are few in number and continue to decline.



Future trends

It is very difficult to predict exactly which sectors of the economy will grow or decline in the future, although commentators do agree that in London, job areas that are forecast to grow by 2036 are in the professional, real estate, scientific and technical activities sector. Information and communication, administrative and support service activities, and accommodation and food service activities are also expected to see large increases in employment numbers.

And don't forget, whatever experts predict for the future of young Londoners, you need to be sure that you plan to carry on learning and training, not only to reach the highest level you can now, but throughout your working life!



Looking for a job

Job search skills are crucial to help you to find a job or an Apprenticeship. Even if you are only looking for a part-time job to help to fund your studies, you will need to know how to write a CV, fill out an application form and be able to do well at interviews.



CV tips

Your CV (Curriculum Vitae) is important because it is a way of advertising yourself so employers will want to meet you. A CV usually includes your contact details, a short personal profile, a list of your education and qualifications, and information about your skills and work experience.



Getting an interview

Hopefully, your CV or application will result in a letter or email inviting you to an interview. You will need to reply to confirm that you will be attending and then make sure that you prepare thoroughly. Find out as much information you can about the employer, check that you know how to get there and try to think about the questions you may be asked and a couple of questions that you would like to ask.



Application forms

You may need to fill out a paper or online application form for a job, course or an Apprenticeship. There are some basic rules to help you:

- Always read the instructions first
- Make sure that your spelling is perfect
- Complete every section of the form
- Read all the information you have about the opportunity and try to match your skills
- Before you post, email or click "send" make sure you read, check and check again



Voluntary work

While you are looking for work you could volunteer. Some young people take a gap year before university and spend some time working on a voluntary project. You won't be making money while you are volunteering, but you will gain personal benefits and develop your confidence, learn new skills and may have the chance to get some extra qualifications.



Start your own business

A survey by the Prince's Trust reported that 30 per cent of 16-30 year olds want to work for themselves – and that many of those same people expect to achieve that goal within the next five years. Television programmes such as Dragon's Den and The Apprentice have made the idea of self-employment very popular. Famous entrepreneurs, including Londoner Sir Alan Sugar, are as famous as sports and film stars - there have even been Hollywood films made about Facebook founder, Mark Zuckerberg and Apple Co-Founder, Steve Jobs! 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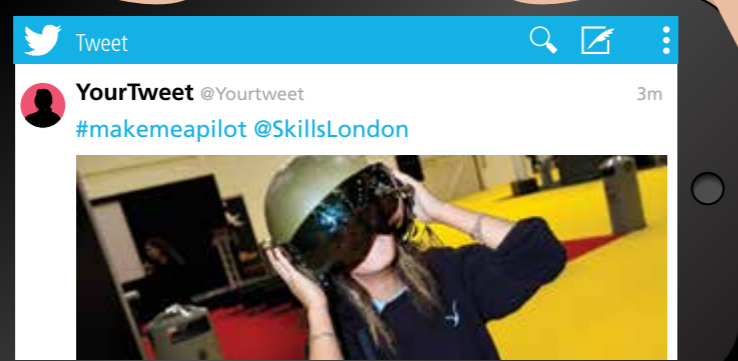
